Introducing Geelong Children's Clinic

Four paediatricians are available at the Geelong Children's Clinic.

Dr. Philippa Shilson. Special interests include poor growth and oral aversion, paediatric gynaecology, congenital abnormalities, severe eczema, obesity and child neglect.

Dr Emily Reid. All infants under 12 months of age and children with multiple complex medical conditions, including asthma, eczema, recurrent infections, poor growth, genetic syndromes, and developmental concerns, indigenous child health, cerebral palsy, headaches, continence issues and sleep difficulties.

Dr Lawrence Gray. All paediatric medical and developmental concerns, including respiratory symptoms, asthma, eczema, and allergies, infant distress, and sleeping or feeding concerns, bedwetting and constipation, issues with growth/puberty and adolescent health.

Dr John Massie. John is a consultant in respiratory medicine at RCH and accepts referrals from GPs and Paediatricians regarding respiratory medicine.

Waiting times vary on condition and paediatrician. Refer by fax or ReferralNet with a letter. Geelong Children's clinic will get in touch with the patient for first available appointment.
